What is happening at the event?

Where is the event?

The event is being held at the Bellingen Showgrounds, entrance to the event site is via the Black Street entrance. Gates open at 5pm.

How to get to the event & parking

Bellingen Showgrounds is located on the north side of town across the Lavenders Bridge and is easy walking distance from town and North Bellingen. If you live close by, we encourage you to walk. Enter the site through the Black Street entrance.

For those that do need to drive, there is no parking in the showgrounds, but is available on the side streets around the showground. Please be mindful of our neighbours when parking.

What if it is raining on the day?

We will be monitoring the weather in the lead up to the event, if the forecast is for rain we will postpone the event and notify ticket holders and via our social media a few days prior.

No Go Items

These items are prohibited in the event site for the safety of everyone:

- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- Knives and/or weapons of any kind
- Fireworks, flares and/or fire twirling equipment
- Laser lights
- Video and audio recording devices, including Go Pros
- Drones
- Animals (with the exception of service or assistance animals)

Conditions of Entry

- No Ticket, No Entry.
- No go items are not allowed in the event area.
- Strictly no video recordings of the screen are to be made during the film screening.
- Mobile phones turned off or on silent during the film screening.
